#### **DISASSEMBLY**

1. Remove the bottom of the rear seat by depressing the two (2) plastic clips located under the front edge on each side.



2. Remove the seat belt guides from the upper quarter trim panels.




3. Pull up evenly on the upper quarter trim panels to release the plastic retainers. Use caution to not damage them.



4. Disconnect the electrical connectors located behind the seat belt guides (if equipped) and remove the upper quarter trim panels.



5. Cut out the trim panel templates that are provided on the last page of this installation manual. Be sure to measure the templates to ensure they have printed to scale.



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6. Place the upper quarter trim panels upside down on a non-marring surface and place the templates in the areas as shown in the picture below.



7. Using a center punch, mark the pilot hole locations as shown below.



8. Drill the pilot holes with a 1/8" drill bit.



9. Turn the panels over and drill through the pilot holes with a 2" hole saw. If needed, apply masking tape to the surface to protect it from being damaged by the hole saw.



 Pull inwards on the quarter trim panels to remove them. Note: The lower portion can remain in the vehicle.








11. Remove three (3) 10 mm nuts, one (1) 7 mm screw and disconnect the electrical connectors to remove the speaker assemblies from each side of the vehicle. On the passenger side, remove one (1) 10 mm stud and one (1) 7 mm screw to remove the electrical component that is located on the B-pillar. Set each speaker assembly to the side on a non-marring surface.



12. Remove the rubber grommet on each side of the vehicle.



13. Remove one (1) 10 mm screw just behind the seat belt on each side of the vehicle as shown.



14. Remove one (1) 15 mm screw on each side of the vehicle as shown below.



#### **ASSEMBLY**

1. Install each mounting bracket by first reinstalling the one (1) 10 mm screw on each side of the vehicle that was removed in step 13 of the disassembly section. Torque to no more than 80 in-lb.






2. Reinstall the one (1) 15 mm screw on each side of the vehicle that was removed in step 14 of the disassembly section. Torque to 25 Nm.



3. Install the one (1) 5/16" button head screw (P/N: 117000) and one (1) 5/16" serrated flange nut (P/N: 117001) into each bracket in the location shown below.





4. Reinstall the rubber grommets that were removed in step 12 of the disassembly section.



Reverse steps 10-11 of the disassembly section, in order to reinstall the speaker assemblies and quarter trim panels.







6. Reverse steps 1-4 of the disassembly section to reinstall the upper quarter trim panels and the bottom of the rear seat. **Note:** Be sure the upper quarter trim panels are tucked behind the convertible top to keep from damaging them.





7. Install the stylebar (P/N: 0511-7000-01-NL) by sliding each post through the upper quarter trim panels and into the mounting brackets. Verify that the style bar is the correct orientation as shown. Tighten the set screws on each side with a 1/4" long-reach allen wrench.



3. Congratulations, the installation is complete.
