

## Tools required:

Jack and jackstands

Ratchet

Sockets - 13mm deep, 15mm deep

Extension

10mm wrench

Pliers or cutoff tool

- 1. Disconnect battery using 10mm wrench.
- 2. Using 15mm socket and extension, remove driver and passenger upper motor mount nuts as shown in **IMAGE 1**.
- 3. Lift vehicle and support securely with jack stands. Using an engine support bar or jack, support the engine.
- 4. Remove four 13mm bolts from passenger side engine stand as shown in IMAGE 2.






5. Install passenger side motor mount using supplied 15mm hardware as shown in **IMAGE 3**. **NOTE: Tabs on ground strap need to be flattened as shown in IMAGE 4**. Alternatively, you can cut the tabs off the strap, or cut the OEM stud and reuse it in the original mounting location. See IMAGE 5 and 6.




- 6. Remove four 13mm bolts from drivers side engine stand as shown in **IMAGE 7**.
- 7. Install drivers side engine stand using supplied 15mm hardware as shown in **IMAGE 8**.

- 8. Lower engine until it sits on new motor mounts.
- 9. Install upper motor mount nuts.
- 10. Lower vehicle and connect battery.

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
