Instructions Rear Diff Bushings

N.B: This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual and proper safety procedures followed.

• Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.

Never rely on a Jack only

Note - the rear Sub-frame will have to be removed and lowered onto a table/bench.

Careful of brake lines.

Mark the tail shaft with the diff pinion - so to bolt up back in the same spot - to prevent vibration.

• Remove Diff from Sub-frame.

• The original bushings will have to be removed including the outer shell. Drill a hole in rubber and use a Air-hacksaw to cut a slit in outer shell.

Alternatively use a threaded rod/bolt and steel cups - and pull/push bushing out.


